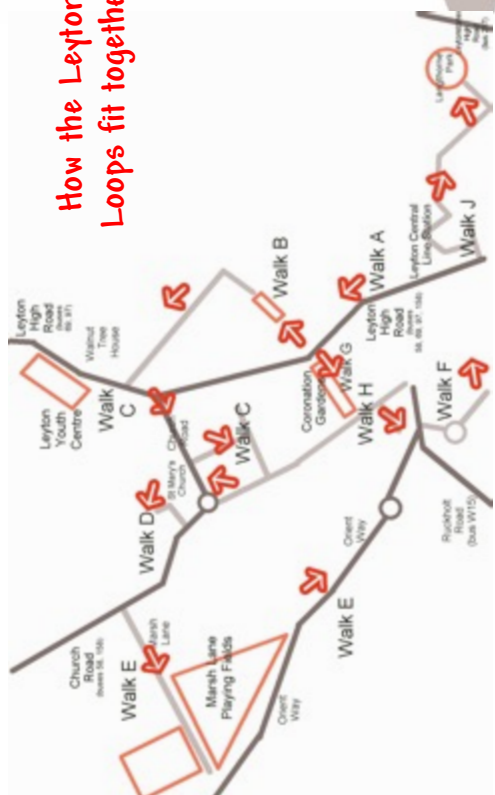


diagram map of Walk A

Leyton Central Line Station to Coronation Gardens

a short, easy walk of 1/3 mile / 1/2 kilometre



This route is suitable for wheelchairs and children's buggies if you are careful



Walk

A

from Leyton Central Line Station as far as the High Road entrance to Coronation Gardens (a short, easy walk)



Start at Leyton Tube Station (Central Line), buses 58, 69, 97, 158

Cross the road to the other side



Turn right towards the shopping centre

Go past the shopping centre

At the traffic lights keep straight on and cross Alexandra Road (carefully !)



At the next traffic lights keep straight on again and cross Ruckholt Road to the Library



Next to the Library is the former Leyton Town Hall



Cafes on the other side of the road



The entrance to Coronation Gardens is further along the High Road, on the left, past the public toilet. There are seats in Coronation Gardens.

Buses 58, 69, 97 and 158 go along this section of the High Road - OR you can take Walk G to Oliver Road, or B to Walnut Tree House (see separate leaflets)
