



After looking at the cricket pavilion, go back across the High Road, and take Jesse Road (opposite the cricket ground wall and railings) for Walnut Tree House.

Buses 69 and 97 go along this section of the High Road - OR you can take Walk C to Oliver Road (see separate leaflet)

This route is suitable for wheelchairs and children's buggies if you are careful

from the Leyton High Road end of Coronation Gardens to Walnut Tree House and the Leyton Youth Centre (the former Essex County Cricket Ground)  
(a walk on tarmac and paved surfaces, level ground, of 2/3 mile / 1 kilometre)

Buses 58, 69, 97 and 158 pass the entrance to Coronation Gardens



Take Sidmouth Road opposite Coronation Gardens



go into Sidmouth Park



go through the Park (which has an adventure playground on the right, and under 5s play area at the other end)



leave Sidmouth Park and go into Dawlish Road



past the Newport Schools nature area



Follow the sharp left-hand bend in Dawlish Road



past the Noor Ul Islam Primary School, and then walk the length of Dawlish Road



past the electricity substation



cross the busy Leyton High Road, and turn right



The entrance to Leyton Youth Centre (the former Essex County Cricket Ground) is after the Crawley Road turning
