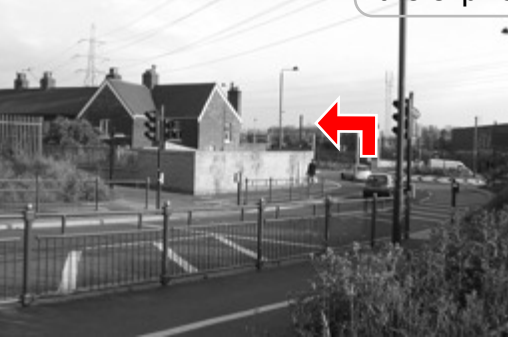
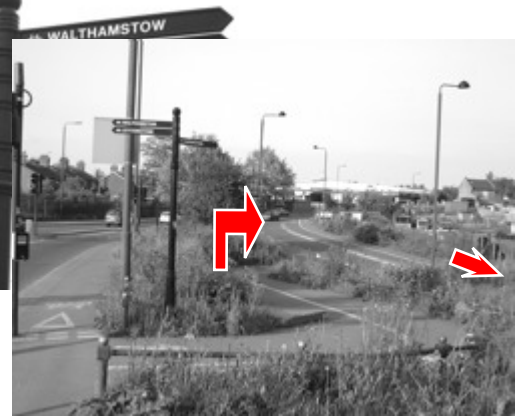
This walk starts at the junction of Ruckholt Road with Orient Way and Marshall Road



Take the cycle path down to the slip road



Take the cycle path down to the slip road



Cross the slip road and turn left at the roundabout into Marshall Road



At the end of Marshall Road is the Leyton Mills retail estate



Walk through the large car park, the route W14 bus stand, and past Asda to T K Maxx and Fitness First



At the end of the retail estate are steps and a ramp to Leyton High Road



On Leyton High Road turn right to a bus stop (routes 58, 69, 97 and 158) and a pedestrian crossing to Leyton tube station.
